Is your child not yet attempting to make consonant sounds for words? Does your child leave off the beginning or end of his or her words? Can he or she never seem to get sounds in the order they need to be?

Erin Bernett, M.S., CCC-SLP is presenting a workshop on April 12 at the Child Study Center in Fort Worth for parents, teachers and therapists who are interested in using visual cues to prompt children for clearer speech intelligibility. Erin is a speech pathologist in private practice with 10 years of experience working with children with Down syndrome and other disorders who have a difficult time with motor planning sounds for clear speech. Green Oaks School in Arlington and many families in the DFW area use the cue system she developed. During the workshop, Erin discusses why cueing a child visually for sounds is more effective than having a child say a word repeatedly to make the word sound better. She teaches parents a systematic way to introduce sounds to their child through seeing, feeling, moving and hearing. At the end of the workshop, parents and professionals will leave with a set of sound cards, hands-on knowledge of the cue system and a clear plan of how to get started cueing their child to clearer speech!
